- 1801 Cell – billed for 18 plants.

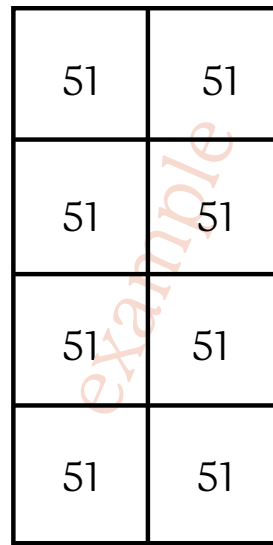
SOIL MIX: Items are grown in either a soil based mix or Elle pots.

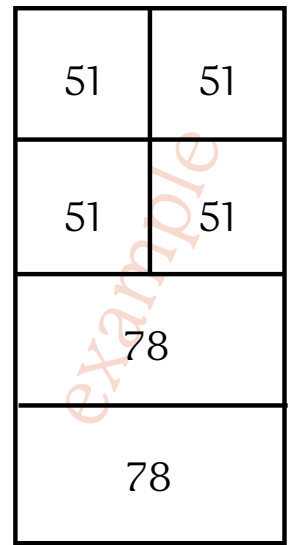
CLAIMS: Any damages to, loss of, shortage in, or any other claim concerning the goods which could be discovered by inspection upon delivery of the goods, must be reported to seller promptly and in no event later than forty eight (48) hours after delivery of the goods to buyer or their destination. Photos are required for all claims. In the case of any such claim against seller, inspection shall be promptly arranged with seller. Any damage, loss or shortage occurring in transit must be settled by buyer with seller without offset of, or deduction from the purchase price of the goods affected. Buyer shall set aside, protect and hold those goods which are the subject of its claim, without further processing, until seller has an opportunity to inspect them and advise buyer of the disposition, if any, to be made of them. In no case shall any goods be returned without first securing the written authority of seller.

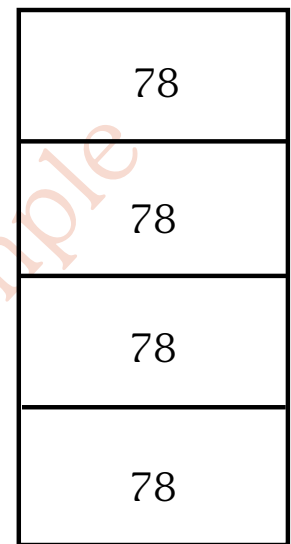
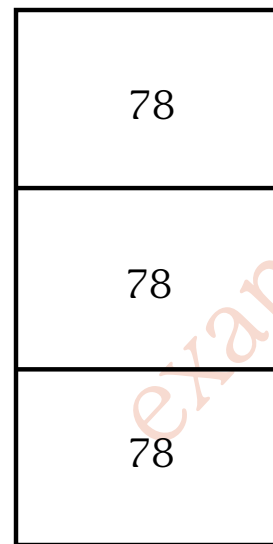
TERM OF SALE: Direct order terms: Full payment upon receipt of product, unless other arrangements have been made.



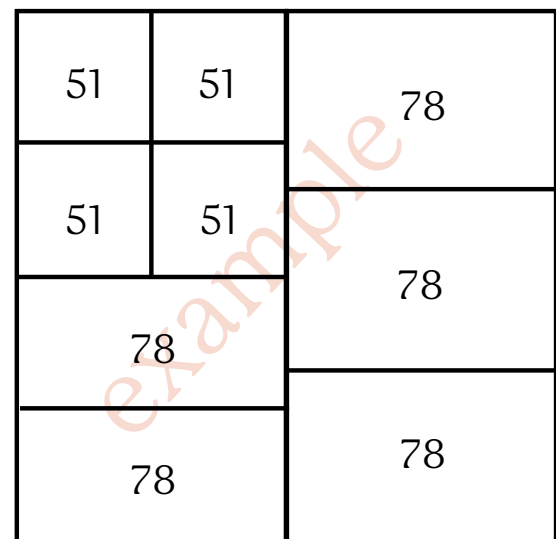
A MINI BOX fits 8 51-trays

A MASTER BOX can hold double the trays as a MINI. Here is an example of a mixed MASTER BOX.








SHIPPING
